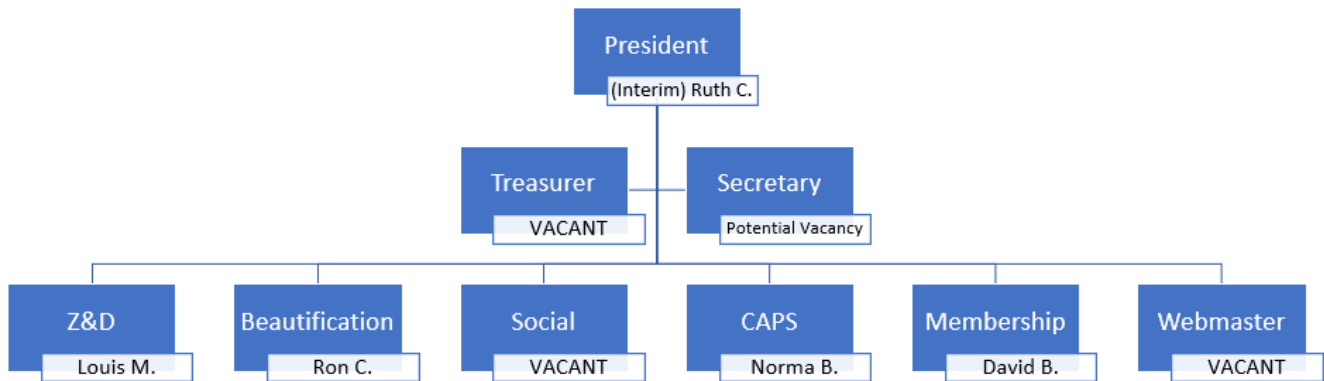
1. Intros – welcome to any new LANA members!

**Treasurer** - Oversees bank account, spending, and fiscal documentation for block club activities.

**Secretary** - The Secretary prepares all meeting notes and communications from the Association and receives a copy of all communications received by the Association. In the absence of the President, the Secretary presides at meetings.
