

HISTORY WITH PIPELINE

1/31/2019 - Pipeline acquires Weiss, Westlake and West Suburban from Tenet, promising to continue operating all 3 as hospitals

Early Feb. 2019 - Pipeline requests exemption from IHFSRB (Illinois Health Facilities State Review Board) for Westlake allowing them to transfer \$ between Westlake and their other hospitals

2/19/2019 - Pipeline closes Westlake Hospital

Early Oct. 2019 – Pipeline requests exemption from IHFSRB for Weiss (meeting in later October.)

10/17/2019 – State reps request answers from Pipeline regarding Weiss request, concerned about potential risk of Weiss closure (**STATE REP LETTER ATTACHED**)

10/22/2019 – IHFSRB Meeting Scheduled - Pipeline requests exemption for Weiss; request delayed due to lack of response to State reps.

Early November 2019 – LANA learns of **CBRE Development Prospectus** for surface lot

11/4/2019 – Community meeting between LANA and Pipeline open to full public (**1st LANA LETTER**)

11/19/2019 – Community meeting between LANA stakeholders only and Pipeline - Pipeline agrees to consider MOU

12/10/2019 – IHFSRB Meeting for Pipeline’s delayed request. LANA prepares a (**2nd LANA LETTER**) Pipeline withdraws request the morning of the meeting, plans to seek exemption at February IHFSRB meeting

3/9/2020 – Pipeline drops IHFSRB request, requests additional community meeting with LANA

---Global Pandemic---

7/28/2020 – Pipeline pays 1.5M to resolve a 2019 lawsuit in which Melrose Park claimed Pipeline acquired the 230-bed Westlake hospital under false pretenses

12/10/2020 – LANA learns of Lincoln Properties development proposal for 4600 N Marine Dr.; holds internal meeting

1/28/2021 – LANA meets with Lincoln Properties and views the proposal for 4600 N Marine Dr. LANA begins collecting feedback from community

3/18/2021 – Second LANA meeting with Lincoln Properties, questions submitted
